- **In 2014, 170,100** irregular migrants were recorded arriving in Italy by sea (an increase from 42,925 arrivals recorded
- **In 2013, 141,484** of them leaving from Libya.<sup>[17]</sup> Most of them came from the [Horn of Africa](#) and West Africa.<sup>[18][19]</sup> ○ **Illegal immigration from Africa to Europe is significant.** Many people from poor African countries embark on the dangerous journey for Europe, in hopes of a better life. In parts of Africa, particularly Mauritania and Morocco, trafficking of immigrants to Europe has become more lucrative than drug trafficking. **SEE YOU IN CAPE TOWN**
